The government has set a target of delivering 3 million apprenticeships by 2020 it's a tall order but we are pleased to be doing our bit. Apprenticeships are real jobs that give people the opportunity to train and become fully competent while earning money.

In fact so many young people have a degree these days that employers are searching for points of differentiation and real work experience is a key advantage when job-hunting.
